### NARRATIVE

On 11/27/2025 I was dispatched to 361556 Pine St Hilliard, Fl in reference to a domestic battery.

Upon my arrival, I made contact with the juvenile subject, Lucy Dufault, who was visually upset, crying, and taking short breaths. Lucy stated she was scared and that she wanted to know what was going to happen to her. I asked Lucy what events happened leading up to this point. She explained that she has anxiety and has trouble staying calm when her mother, Erin Schreiber, is "ignoring" her or acting like "she isn't there". She stated earlier in the day, before leaving their residence, she was asking her mother questions and her mother would not answer her. Lucy stated this made her upset so she went and sat in the car to wait on her mother. She sat in the passenger seat with her feet on the dash and due to her anger, she was putting pressure on the windshield. When she added more pressure to the windshield, it caused damage to it leaving a crack. I then asked Lucy if she harmed her mother that day, she stated when she was upset and having an episode, she hit her mother. I asked Lucy if she wanted to cause harm to her mother and she said she did not want to cause harm but when she feels angry, she lashes out and hits her mother.

I spoke with Erin, she stated she did leave damage on the windshield due to pressure from her feet. I asked Erin what happened when Lucy hit her, Erin advised me they were driving down CR 108 when Lucy attempted to open the door and get out of the car. She stated she stopped on the side of the road for her safety and to try to calm her down. As they were driving further down the road, she said Lucy was still upset from the events earlier in the day and began to hit her on her arm multiple times while she was driving.

As I was speaking with Erin, she stated she has taken Lucy to the hospital to speak with a psychiatrist due to mental health issues in attempts to get help for her. She has also set up appointments with a counselor but did not have success due to Lucy not wanting to fully participate. Erin stated Lucy has also received a juvenile citation for a domestic battery previously as well.

It should be known, that there is a substantial likelihood that without care or treatment Lucy could cause harm or serious bodily injury to herself or others.

Lucy was transported to MHRC located at 20th St, Jacksonville Fl under a Baker Act.
